- (ii) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/college as Assistant Professor/ Associate Professor/ Professor, and/or research experience at equivalent level at the University/National Level Institutions with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.

OR

B. An outstanding professional, having a Ph.D. degree in the relevant/ allied/ applied disciplines, from any academic institutions (not included in A above)/ industry, who has made significant contribution to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, supported by documentary evidence provided he/ she has ten years' experience.

ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR

- (i) A good academic record, with a Ph.D degree in the concerned/allied/ relevant disciplines.
- (ii) A Master's Degree with atleast 55% marks(or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed).

- i) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
 - A relaxation of 5% shall be allowed at the Bachelor's as well as at the Master's level for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/ Backward Classes 'A' & 'B' (Noncreamy Layer) of Haryana/Differently-abled ((a) Blindness and low vision; (b) Deaf and Hard of Hearing; (c) Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid-attack victims and muscular dystrophy; (d) Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness; (e) Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under (a) to (d) including deaf-blindness) for the purpose of eligibility and assessing good academic record for direct recruitment. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedure.
- Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SELT/SET:

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/sported by the UGC/ICSSR/CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfillment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

- Note: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.
- (iii) A relaxation of 5% shall be provided, (from 55% to 50% of the marks) to the Ph.D. Degree holders who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19 September, 1991.

- 9. The applicant has to submit the hard copies/ reprints of research publications alongwith the page(s), ISBN/ ISSN and content page(s) of each book/journal {(Pear-Reviewed or UGC-listed Journals(Impact factor to be determined as per Thomson Reuters list)}/ Proceeding in which the publication(s) under reference is/ are published must be numbered in sequence and be filled against their entries in the application form
- 10. Incomplete applications and those not on prescribed form or without fee and supporting documents will be summarily rejected and not accepted in any case.
- 11. Those who are in service must send their application through proper channel.
- 12. The University reserves the right to increase/decrease the number of posts or it may not fill any of the posts advertised without assigning any reason.
- 13. Preference will be given to Ph.D. holders, who have obtained their degree from "A" Grade or higher grade NAAC Accredited University/Institution.
- 14. No rounding off shall be carried out to compute the merit points. The number should be accurate upto two decimal places.
- 15. The time taken by candidates to acquire Ph.D. degree shall not be considered as teaching/research experience to be claimed for appointment to the teaching positions. Further, the period of active service spent on pursuing Research Degree simultaneously with teaching assignment without taking any kind of leave, shall be counted as teaching experience for the purpose of direct recruitment. The candidates are required to submit the proof of date of registration and award/notification of Ph.D. degree/ provisional Ph.D. degree. A certificate is also required from the candidate that he/she has pursued research degree with teaching assignment without taking any kind of leave.

- 16. The applicants who have registered for Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009 and have been awarded the degree, are required to produce a certificate for the fulfilment of the conditions to be issued by the Registrar or Dean (Academic Affairs) of the concerned University as per Annexure-I.
- 17. The applicants who have registered for Ph.D. programme on or after July 11, 2009 are required to produce a certificate for the fulfilment of the provisions of the UGC (minimum standards and procedure for award of Ph.D. degree) Regulations, 2009 to be issued by the Registrar or Dean (Academic Affairs) of the concerned University as per Annexure-II.
- 18. The degrees obtained by the candidates through Distance Education Mode/ Correspondence Mode must be approved by AICTE-UGC-DEC (now DEB) and proof of the same be enclosed.

They will not be considered against reserved seats. However such candidates should fulfill conditions of eligibility regarding age etc. as are meant for the General

Hence, this department being a Nodal agency of the Government for implementation negers candidates of the reservation policy issue this clarification that Government Department must follow the above instruction dated 25.06.1997. These instructions were issued in connection with the reservation policy pertaining to Govt, job. On the same analogy; the Scheduled Castes/Backward Classes candidate who get selected/admitted in Educational/Professional/Technical Institution and precisities in the open competition on the basis of their own merit, they will not be counted against its sports reserved for Scheduled Castes Backward Classes, rather they will be treated as open e petition candidates. Cases where a reserved category candidate avail relaxation say in age. qualifying norms etc. then he/she will be treated against reserve eategory.

i) Paper in refereed journals without impact factor - 5 Points
ii) Paper with impact factor less than 1 - 10 Points
iii) Paper with impact factor between 1 and 2 - 15 Points
iv) Paper with impact factor between 2 and 5 - 20 Points

Description impact factor between 5 and 10 - 25 Points

v) Paper with impact factor between 5 and 10 - 25 Points
vi) Paper with impact factor>10 - 30 Points

(a) Two authors: 70% of total value of publication for each author.

(b) More than two authors: 70% of total value of publication for the First/Principal/Corresponding author and 30% of total value of publication for each of the joint authors.

Joint Projects: Principal Investigator and Co-investigator would get 50% each.

Note:

Paper presented if part of edited book or proceeding then it can be claimed only once.

For joint supervision of research students, the formula shall be 70% of the total score for Supervisor and Co-supervisor. Supervisor and Co-supervisor, both shall get 7 marks each.

*For the purpose of calculating research score of the teacher, the combined research score from the categories of 5(b): Policy Document and 6: Invited lectures/Resource Person/Paper presentation shall have an upper capping of thirty percent of the total research score of the teacher concerned.

The research score shall be from the minimum of three categories out of six categories.

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
