Faculty members must have a portfolio of engagements, including research, teaching, training/extension and consulting. There is a provision for sharing the consulting income of the Institute. IRMA offers an attractive salary and other benefits like DA, LTA, HRA/Campus Housing, Medical reimbursement, Children's Education reimbursement, PF, Gratuity on completing five years, Casual Leave, Half Pay/Sick Leave, Vacation Leave, Sabbatical Leave etc.
