Requirement	 i. Eminent Persons in the field of Rural Development; ii. Senior Bankers with a flair for rural development; iii. Senior Officers both serving and retired from the Government of India/States, Public Sector Undertakings, persons serving in Government/Government Organizations may either be taken on deputation basis or on sanction of study leave by the parent organization for the purpose; iv. Senior academics and scholars working on subjects relating to rural development issues. v. Eminent academicians from abroad (Indian and Foreign origin) working on subjects relating to rural development issues.

Job Description	i. To conduct important research projects on subject of current interest and related to rural development.
	ii. To conduct training programs as per the requirements of the institute and its stakeholders.
	iii. Utilize their experience on matters relating to policy formulation, programme implementation and policy options.
	iv. Provide their services as resources persons in training programmes organized by the Institute.
	v. Augment the quality of the functioning of the Institute and the content of its training courses.
	vi. Any other assignment given by the Director General.
Status and Responsibilities	i. Senior Fellow shall not be treated as an employee of the Institute except for certain facilities and entitlements as may be specifically indicated in the terms and conditions notified in the Offer of Appointment.
	ii. He/She shall report directly to the Director General.
	iii. He/She shall submit periodical progress reports as prescribed by the Director General about the work done by him/her.
	iv. He/She shall submit his/her final report before expiry of the Fellowship period. Publication of the report will be determined by the Director General and the published report shall be the property of the Institute. Rules of the Institute regarding publications shall apply mutatismutandis.
	v. He/She shall not engage himself/herself in any other academic or research in other organizations and shall not accept any other assignment with or without payment during the period of Fellowship

General Conditions:

- 1. An application fee of Rs.300/- should be paid by General/OBC/EWS candidates through Demand Draft, to be drawn in favour of NIRD&PR, payable at Hyderabad. No application fee for SC/ST/PWD candidates.
- 2. The candidates should apply through online registration available on the website http://career.nirdpr.in/
- 3. The print-out of filled-in application form (available on the website) along with Demand Draft, if any is to be sent to National Institute Of Rural Development & Panchayati Raj, Rajendranagar, Hyderabad -500 030.
- 4. Full name of the applicant and the application number should be mentioned on the reverse of the demand draft.
- 5. Application form along with the demand draft, if any should reach NIRD&PR within 30 days from the date of advertisement in the newspaper.
- 6. Applications received with demand draft shall be processed only on and realization of payment.
- 7. Serving officers should forward their application through the cadre controlling authority.
- 8. Retired officers and other applicants not working in any organizations/institutes may forward their applications directly.
- 9. Senior Fellow will be allotted appropriate quarter depending upon availability of the same.
- 10. Headquarters of the Senior Fellows shall be at Hyderabad.
- 11. Candidates may regularly visit the website for further information/updates, if any.
- 12. The shortlisted candidates will be informed about the date, time and venue of the Interview.
- 13. The last date for submitting applications online is 15.08.2022 till 05:30p.m. Applications received after the due date and time will not be considered.
