Vacancy Notice

Applications are invited for one post of one (01) Guest Faculty in the Institute of Forensic Science & Criminology, Panjab University, Chandigarh to be filled through **Walk-in-interview, purely on temporary basis**, for the current academic session 2022-23 (odd semester).

The post is on purely contract basis with honorarium/salary of Rs. 1000/- per lecture with an upper limit of Rs. 25,000/- per month as per Panjab University rules.

Qualifications for the post of Guest Faculty in IFSC:

Essential

1. Good academic record with at least 55% marks (50% for SC/ST/Physically Handicapped) or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed at the Master's Degree level i.e. M.Sc. in Forensic Science or any other allied field from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University as per Panjab University and UGC guidelines.
2. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate, must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) in the relevant discipline conducted by the UGC or a similar test accredited by the UGC or who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time, as the case may be, exempted from NET:

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Byelaws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET for recruitment and appointment of guest faculty subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC / ICSSR/ CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfillment of these conditions is to be certified by the Vice Chancellor or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned. The conditions mentioned above for candidates registered for Ph.D. prior to July 11, 2009 will be applicable.

OR

B. The Ph.D degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

NOTE: Relaxation if any, will be as per P.U. rules. The selected candidates shall be teaching the course content as mentioned in M.Sc. Forensic Science & Criminology (available on PU website) of Panjab University.
