Detailed description of the positions

1. Systems Administrator (One Position)

You will work with the developer team, center faculty, and other teams such as content and project implementation teams at the center – right from the requirements stage to the release of the digital learning platforms and digital interactives, dashboards, and websites.

Key Responsibilities:

- Sys/network related overall tasks: Administration, hosting, provisioning, maintenance, operations & support
- Ownership of CETE data centre - both physical and cloud including security, credentials, user base management
- Life cycle aspects of building, packaging, delivering the software packages for the online and offline learning platforms, EdTech tools and websites
- Ensure 99.99% uptime for all the web services and device mechanisms for backups, fallback, health check, monitoring and analytics
- Work in harmony with the Datacentre of the host organization
- Support teams at the centre, on-campus and remote, for IT services and infrastructure maintenance, troubleshooting and liaising with service providers
- Participate in the conference calls & discussions with the other developers
- Participate in Scrum meeting, discussions, conference calls and work closely and proactively with team members under the guidance of seniors

Desired Profile/Skills:

- Demonstrable experience with networks, web hosting, troubleshooting and allied matters
- Excellent work experience with open source-based systems such as Linux, Systems administration, virtual servers, Git & container/docker based systems – building and packaging installers and patches, bash/shell scripting
- Working knowledge in automation tools such as Jenkins, Puppet, and DevOps tools are a plus.
- Should have knowledge of industry standards around monitoring, alerting, high availability, auto-scaling, etc
- Should have a Process-based approach towards maintaining digital assets – like backup regimens, fail-proofing, hardware health, and capacity monitoring, traffic and usage analysis, software process monitoring
- Know-how of computer hardware and software and debugging skills to troubleshoot common issues
- Good communication skills with diverse teams and ability to use tech platforms for updates, discussions
- Should be an organized, passionate and goal-oriented person who understands what various technology projects have in common, and their strategic role in how the CETE technology efforts can be primed for success
- Exposure to at least one of the cloud platforms AWS/GCP/Azure is a plus

- Prior exposure to Educational Technologies is a plus
- Systems Administration/System Engineer certification in Unix is preferable though not necessary

- Provide contextual support for iterations in research design and tools
- Prepare the reports and literature reviews for sections specific to Nepal/Afghanistan/Maldives
- Manage all data and documents pertaining to the assigned section in both the studies
- Contribute to compiling the Compendium on Action research studies and Guidelines on Distance Teaching-Learning
