- 4. The shortlisted candidates will be called for an interview on 24 January 2023. The interview can be either online or in person depends on the preference given by the candidates. Candidates preferred to appear for interview in person must report at the WII, Dehradun on 24 January 2023 at 9.30 hrs with their filled-in application along with original documents/certificates for verification.
